TERMS OF AGREEMENT - PLEASE READ THOROUGHLY

___ stilt used (\$1.00 each): \$ _____

- \$5.00 minimum total firing charge for any firing temperature.
- Base cost** is calculated in cubic inches (L x W x H) at:
 - \$0.03/cu inch **Low Fire** (bisque or glaze)
 - \$0.04/cu inch **Mid Fire** (cone 5/6)
 - \$0.05/cu inch **High Fire** (cone 10)
- Bulk firing costs** – For cone 5/6 add 20%, and for cone 10 add 30%.
 - \$220/full - \$120/half - \$70/quarter of 12.5 cu ft kiln
 - \$120/full - \$70/half - \$40/quarter of 7 cu ft kiln
 - \$30/full 1 cu ft kiln
- Items over 1" thick require an extra slow sculpture bisque firing and an extra 25% fee will be charged.
- Items may only be glazed on the bottom with prior approval. Stilting or excessive glaze cleaning incurs a \$1.00 charge per piece. Drop-offs that require extra care during loading may incur additional charges.
- Firing schedule is based upon being able to fill a kiln. Average turnaround time is two weeks.
- Items must be picked up within 14 days after contact. Afterwards a \$10.00 per week storage fee will be added.
- Items will be discarded by Clay Planet 45 days after being fired. If you cannot pick up in that time, please call us.

Disclaimer: Clay Planet is not responsible for pieces damaged due to the reasons noted in this disclaimer. Any damage to kilns or shelves caused by customer work and the costs involved in repair of kilns or replacement of shelves will be paid for by the owner of the piece. In some cases, we may require customers to provide a credit card before we fire their work. **We reserve the right to refuse services at our discretion.**

It is your responsibility to ensure all pieces are ready for firing to reduce the chances of the piece damaging or exploding in the kiln. **Pieces must be completely dry** and ready for firing. Your work will be fired alongside others', and you accept the risk of their pieces possibly damaging yours. Remove all interior paper or other material before drop-off. **We will not fire paper clay, glass, or non-clay materials** (except for high-temp wire).

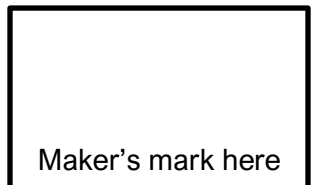
Common Issues: At Clay Planet, experienced potters and technicians perform firings in tested, quality kilns. Firing defects or undesired results may be caused by poor construction, dampness, air bubbles, or improper application of glaze. Be aware there are times when pieces may explode or crack, and glazes may chip, shiver, crawl, or run in the firing. We are happy to provide guidance to aid in preventing these issues from occurring in the future.
